

THE 'PLAYER PROFILE' ART CHALLENGE

DESCRIPTION

A creative challenge where pupils complete a 'Player Profile' card - this helps to highlight all the things they enjoy and why play is important to them. Once they've completed their 'Player Profile' cards, pupils will watch a film showing how UNICEF is protecting play for children around the world.

SET-UP

- Printed 'Player Profile' card for each child – there will be two templates available for different age groups
- Pen, pencils, and anything else they can use to decorate sheets
- Lesson plan/discussion guide for follow-up discussion
- Screen to watch UNICEF film

HOW TO PLAY

This is an opportunity for children to express themselves in their own personal unique way.

- 1 Watch connected 'Player Profile' video intro
- 2 Students complete their own 'Player Profile' card, examples:
 - Decorate the card
 - Picture of me
 - Name
 - Where I live
 - What makes me happy
 - What makes me sad
 - Favourite food
 - Favourite game
- 3 Watch UNICEF film
- 4 Teacher facilitated discussion about the video and the importance for all children to have opportunities to play and how UNICEF is helping to protect play for all children around the world.
